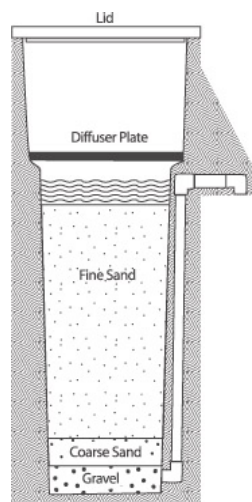


# Sustainable Water Filter Implementation Workshop
